With a nod to the past and a step into the present, this revitalized Mediterranean residence, located on a prominent lane of world class estates, stands alone as an enviable property on over 6 ocean view acres. The intimate main level is anchored by a central atrium in the heart of the home, surrounded by a sumptuous master suite, 2 additional bedrooms, formal dining room, gourmet kitchen and living and family rooms all opening to the



outdoors. The lower level embraces the essence of indoor-outdoor living, with 4 spacious bedrooms, a game room, home theatre, wine cellar, tasting room and a second family room with French doors opening to numerous ocean view patios and entertaining terraces.

CA' DI SOPRA "House Above the Clouds"

- Designed and built 1914–1918 by Bostonian architect, Guy Lowell, with inspiration from the architecture of villas and country homes he visited on his frequent travels in Italy. Lowell's design, infused with the spirit of the Italian countryside, embodies the spirit of Italian architecture in its classical style with numerous porticos, loggias, neo-Greco-Roman pillars and vaulted ceilings with high wooden beams.
- Renovation by D.D. Ford (2002–2006) includes all new surfaces, systems, roof, heating and air, home theatre, walnut flooring as well as antique tiled floors, wine cellar, multi-purpose room, barbecue terrace for dining outside the kitchen, lower level loggia with fireplace and hand stenciled beam ceilings done with a "nod to the romance of the past" and the practical youthful spirit of the present. - Ca' di Sopra is a private "corner of Italy" on the storied Cold Springs Road which opens to with many other grand "Old World" estates as well as the world famous gardens of Lotusland. Features of this authentic heirloom estate include: 6.2+/- ocean view acres with Palladianesque gardens, manicured lawns and hedges, moon shaped infinity pool framed with columns, and terraced gardens of roses, citrus and mature oaks and olive trees. These gardens offer inspiration to those privileged to see its Italian heritage revealed in a 16th century gazebo, numerous water features, and Greco-Roman columns.
